

1. Allship Engineering is an Engineering Company within the Australian Marine Sector. The primary target markets of Allship Engineering are the Defence Marine and Commercial Marine Ship Repair Industries. Allship provides Mechanical Fitting, Rigging, Insulation, as well as a variety of other relevant services through a network of Subcontractors.

 - b. Ensure we work closely with our clients, suppliers, and other stakeholders to continually improve our business processes which affect the environment
 - c. Foster the initiation and ownership of environmental activities by all our staff through education, thereby building a strong environmentally aware business culture.
 - d. Comply with all relevant environmental legislation, regulations, and related policies.
 - e. Ensure Allship conducts assurance and verification activities.
 - f. Timely investigation of Non-Conformance Reports (NCR) and implementation of corrective / preventative actions.
 - g. Reduction in the occurrence and costly impact of nonconformances in terms of reputation, cost, and resources.
 - h. All employees have appropriate knowledge and skills to contribute to the continuous improvement of Allship environmental sustainability.
5. Environmental objectives are set and reviewed during by Management and are subject to change relative to the size and nature of Allship projects, and changes in compliance obligations. Allship is committed to continual improvement through monitoring, recording, and correction of non-conformance, as well as Internal Audit and Management Review.
